



The 2026-2027 Clearfield County Human Services Plan

Mental Health Services

Community Connections of Clearfield & Jefferson Counties has submitted their 26-27 proposed planned expenditures to help a total of 2,378 individuals with \$3,568,138 in Federal, State & County Funding. Services include: Community services, employment, residential, emergency and community driven services, family-based MH, family support, housing, MH crisis intervention, outpatient, peer support, psychiatric inpatient and rehabilitation, social rehabilitation, targeted case management and transitional community integration.

Intellectual Disabilities

Proposes to serve 58 individuals with case management, community-based and residential services with \$2,196,238 in federal state and county funding.

Substance Use Disorder Services

The Clearfield Jefferson Drug & Alcohol Commission continues to see a need for inpatient rehabilitation facilities in the County. D&A reports a decrease in funding \$276,787 in Act 52 and BHSI funding from federal & state funding we propose to serve 247 individuals. Services include: Inpatient non-hospital and Medication assisted therapy.

Homeless Assistance Services

Over the last five years the County has assisted our homeless shelters with funding from the HAP program. We received word that our only family oriented homeless shelter has closed its doors. Haven House in Dubois, PA is not accepting the homeless. The Good Samaritan Shelter (men's shelter) in Clearfield, is currently the only homeless shelter in Clearfield County. The will received \$8,000 in HAP funds.

The Commonwealth increased the Homeless Assistance Program, this will allow Clearfield County to put a few more funds out to the Rental Assistance Program this year. The County vendor is Central PA Community Action, Inc. will have \$56,400 to assists county resident facing eviction, and/or foreclosure.

RACC will introduce a pilot housing case management component with \$2,000 and \$7,176 in administration of the funds and programs.

Humans Services Development Fund

With the Human Services Development Fund (HSDF) Clearfield County will continue to aid the safe visitation and exchanges for children and victim of Domestic Violence. The League on Social Services will provide this service for approximately 35 victims with \$26,900. HSDF funds transferred to CCCJC is 21,180 and CJD&AC is \$25,000. For case management services in the county jail.
